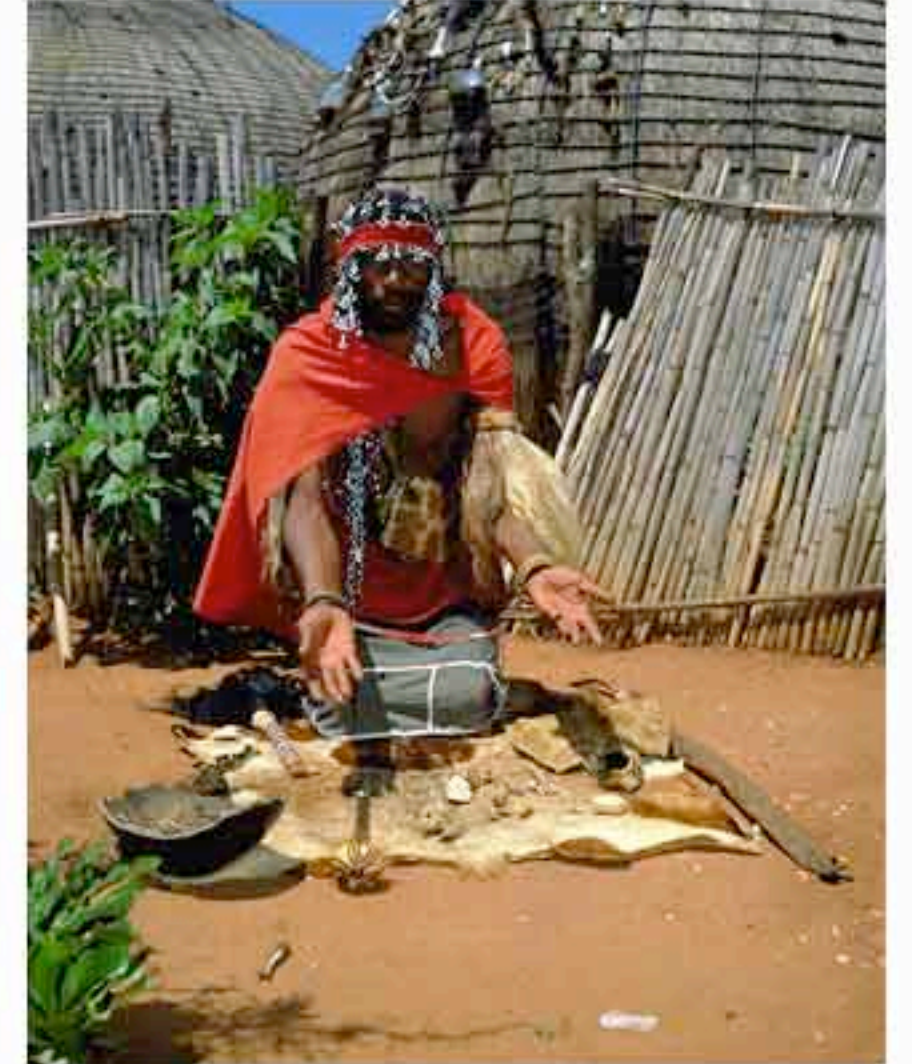


The Origins Experience: Africa /The 'new' Homeopathy

A HOMEOPATHIC SEMINAR IN SOUTH AFRICA – 12 TO 17 MAY 2009



With Dr. Dinesh Chauhan (www.homeohome.com) and specialists in African Culture and Wildlife: African Traditional medicine, animal behavior, the art of tracking and ecology

Africa is understood to be the cradle of mankind where modern hominids evolved about 200,000 years prior to migrating to the Middle East and Europe. The main idea of the seminar is to awaken the powers of observation via the experience of the sensations of wild Africa.

We will start in Durban –the major seaport of the Kwa-Zulu Natal province of South Africa - where we will take a tour of the traditional medicine 'muthi' market. Thereafter we will leave for the bushveld areas of Zululand, about 300km north of Durban. We will locate in a Zululand game reserve for five days and begin by sensitizing ourselves to the environment, slowing down, feeling the primordial peace of the African bush, noticing the small things that make up the ecology.

At this stage we would also receive workshops on the art of tracking – there is a relationship between tracking animals and the new case witnessing methods in homeopathy. In general we will do early morning bush explorations followed by breakfast. The rest of the day will be divided between Dr. Dinesh Chauhan teaching his case witnessing methods followed by video case examples and lectures/inputs on African Ecology, Traditional medicine etc.

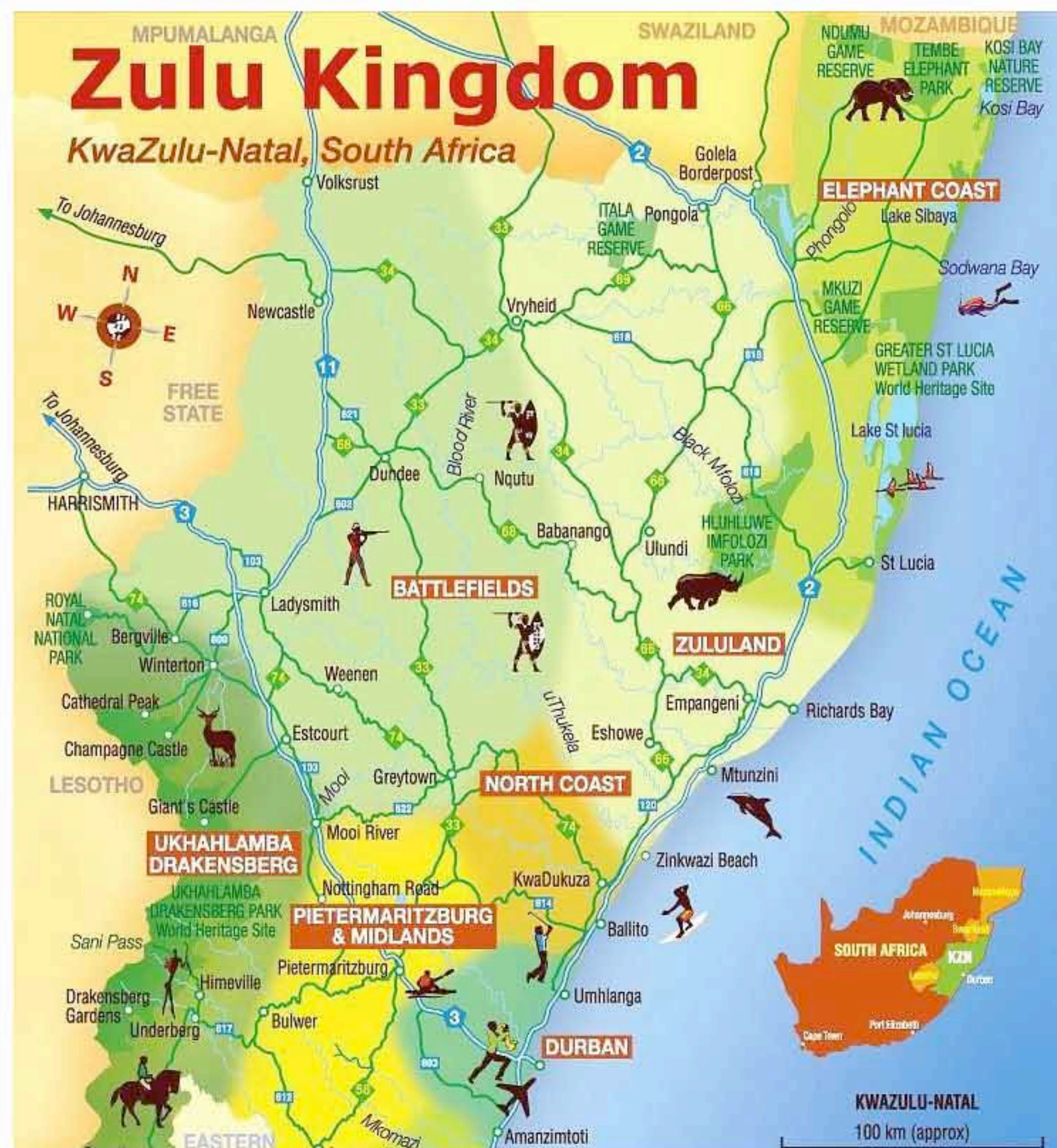
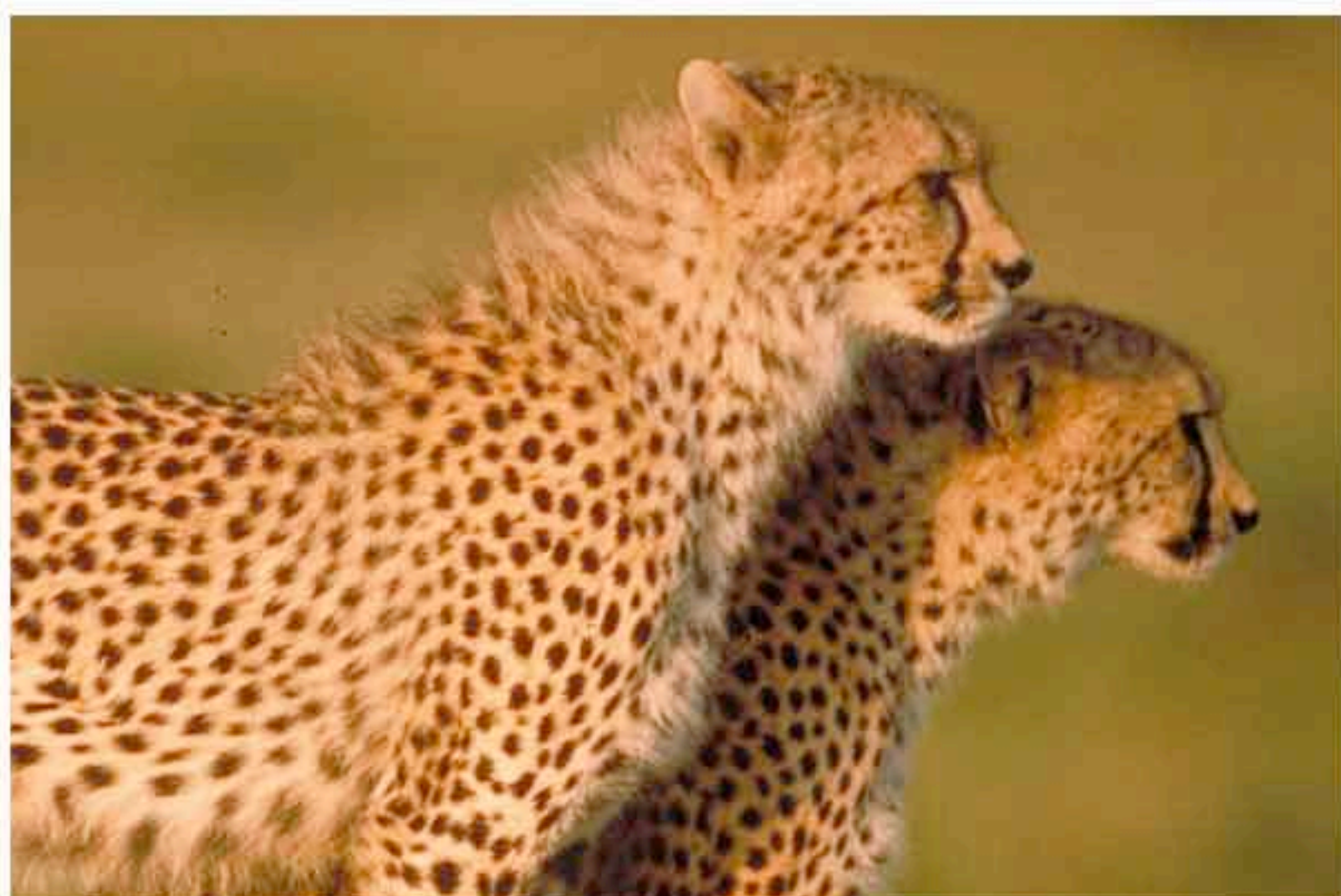
In general the focus of the seminar is on the animal kingdom. For the next days we will look at the larger flagship species, the so called big 5: lion, leopard, Elephant, Rhino and Buffalo.

Dr Dinesh's homeopathic lectures and cases will now revolve around the mammal group drawing a distinction between the carnivores and herbivores with a focus on the cat family as sub group within the mammals. We will also look at plant families that are found in that area and used in traditional African medicine with a view to discovering the links between homeopathic botanical family knowledge, traditional medical use and the actual form and habitat of the plant.
